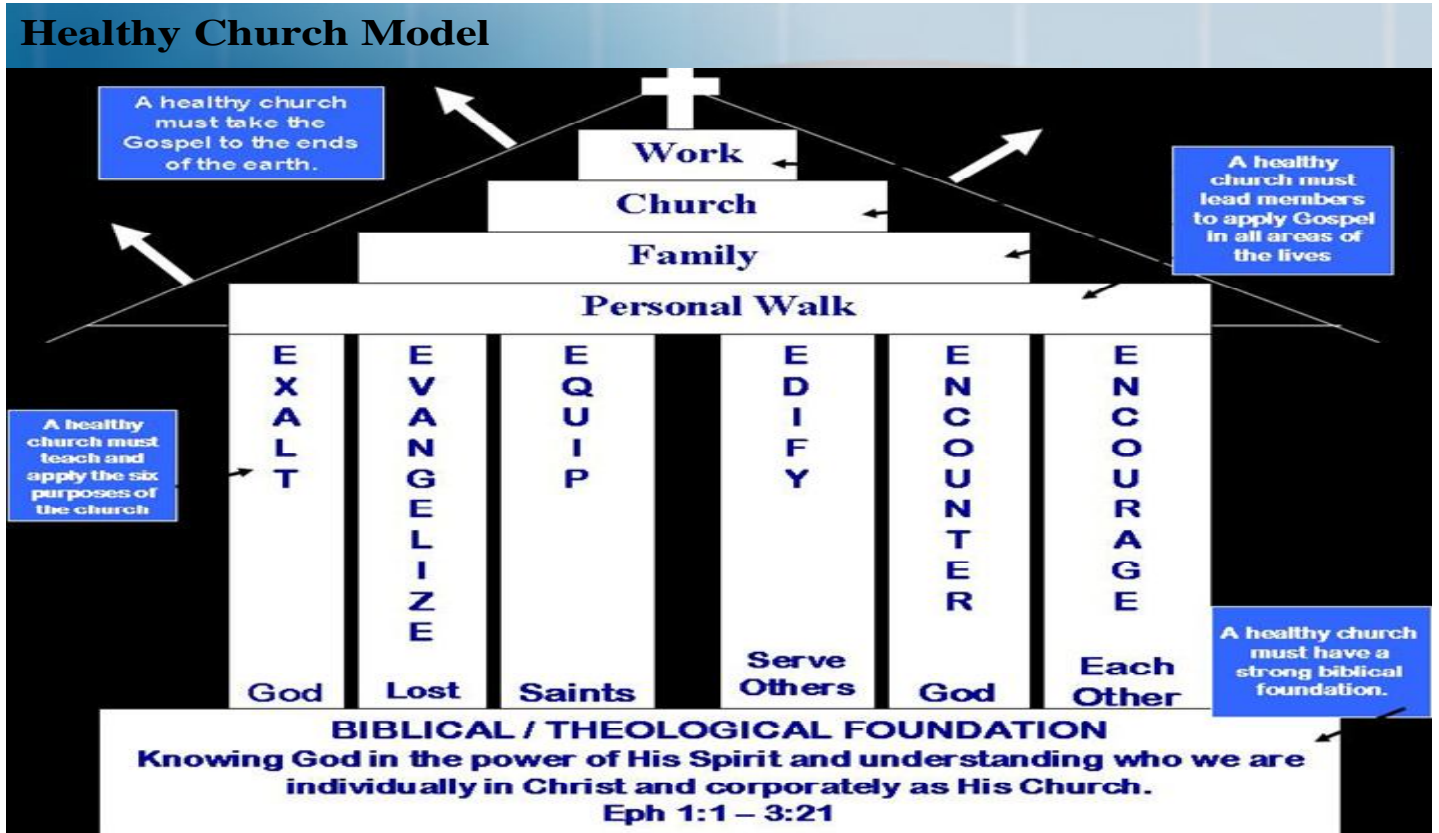


Divinely Designed By God Part 4

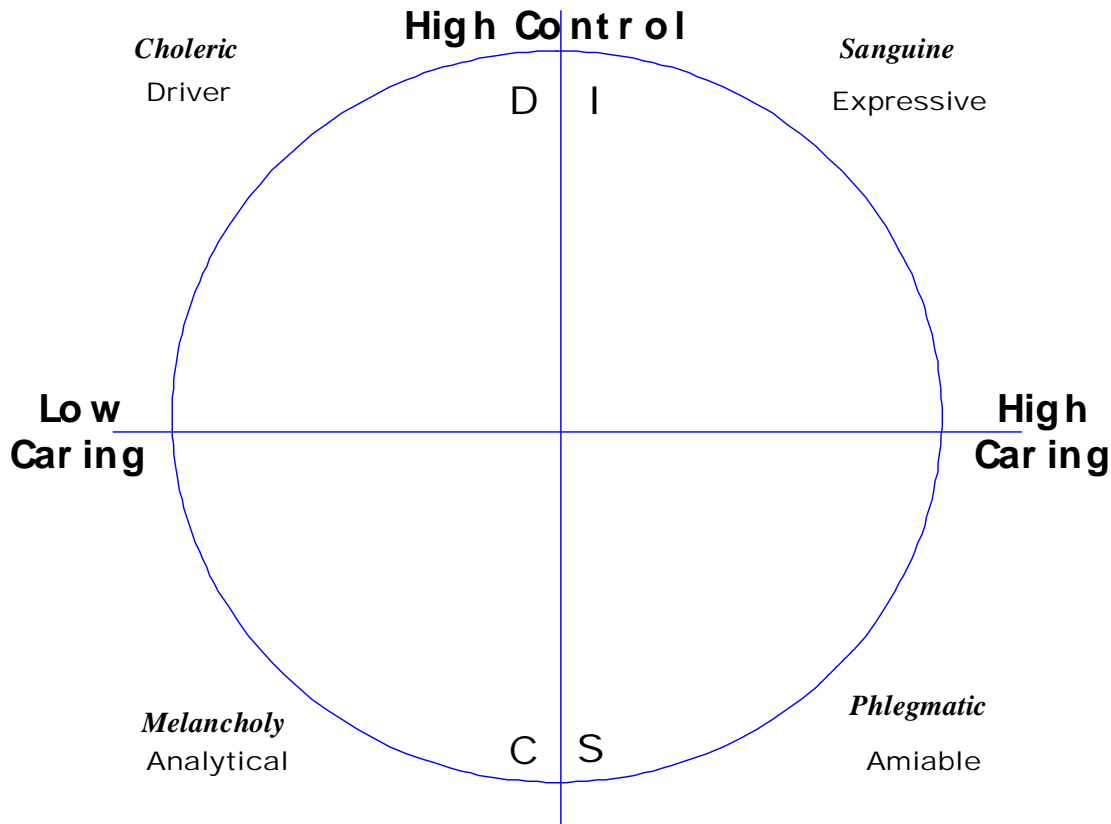
5. God never intended for people in the body of Christ to compete against each other but to complement and support one another in ministry.

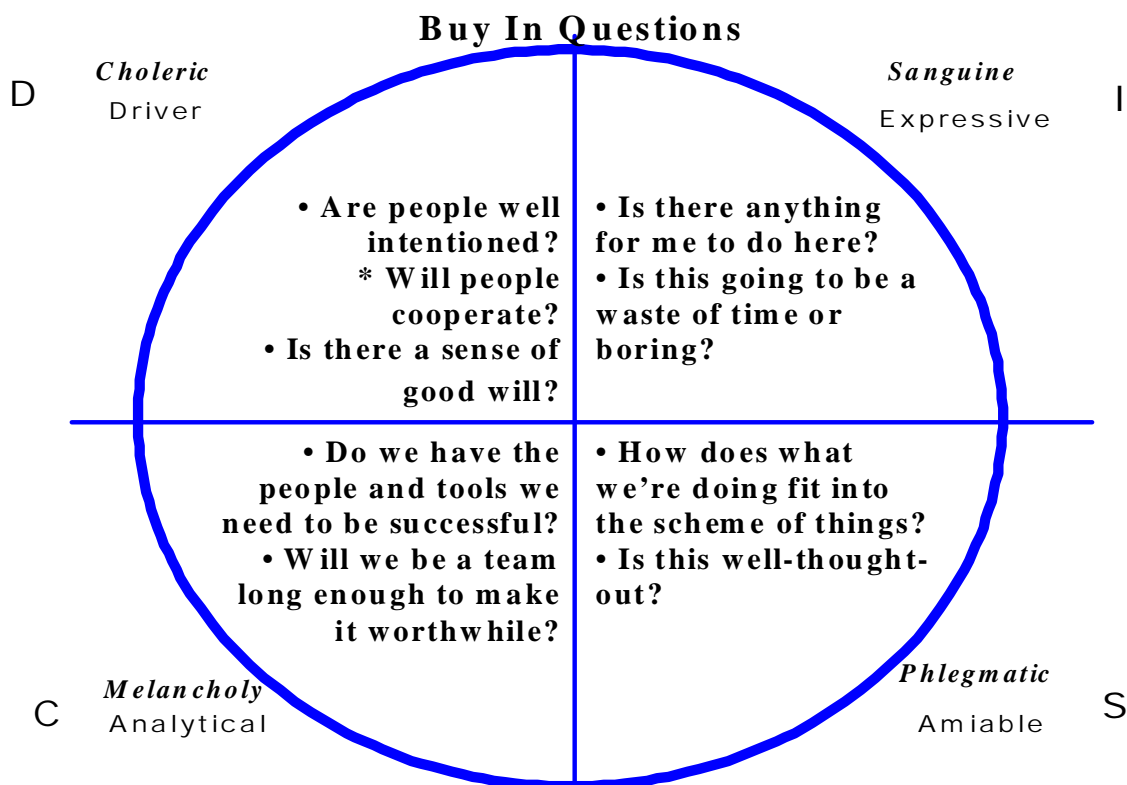
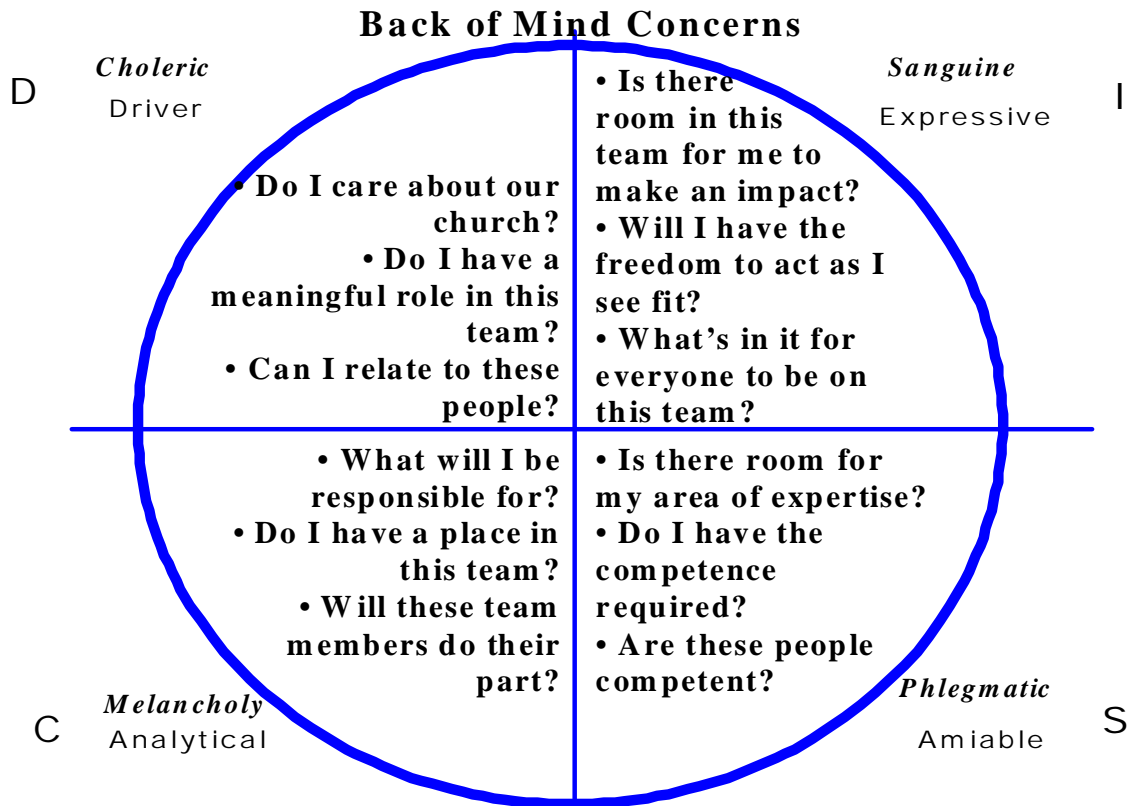
CORE NEEDS - Being apart, connected, Responsibility

STRESSORS - Abandonment, Insubordination, Lack of Belonging

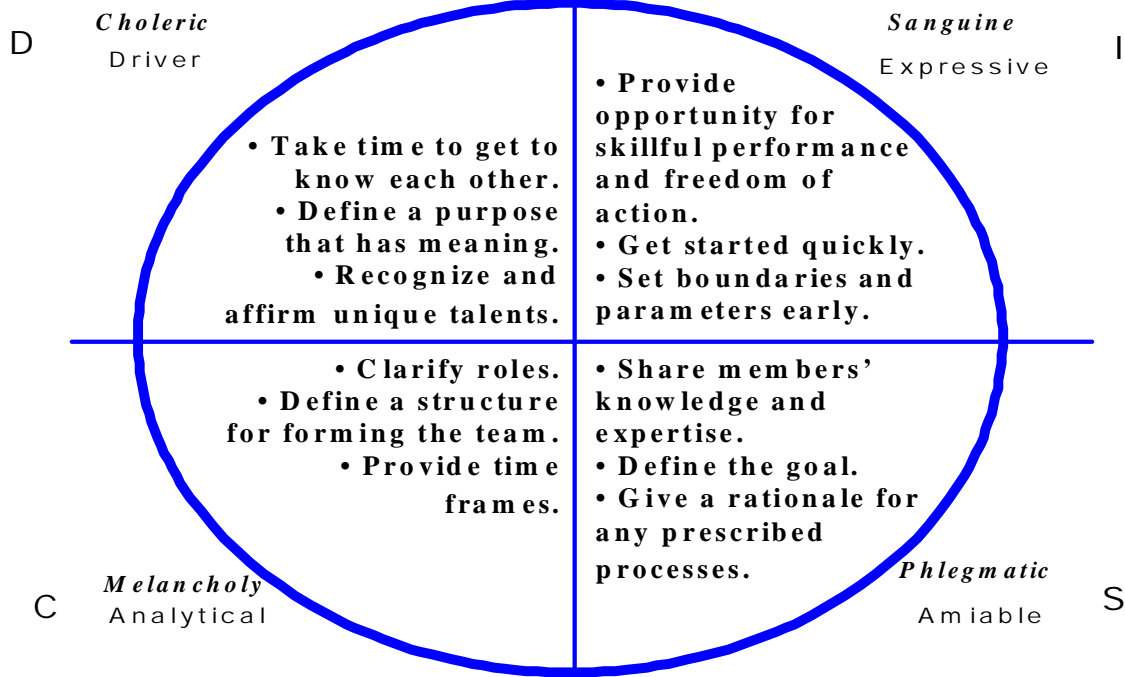
WHEN STRESSED - Complains, Becomes "Sick, Tired, Sorry, Worried"

20. Paul's Response (16:25)
- A. Walked In Unity – “Paul and Silas”
 - B. Walked In Victory “praying and singing”
 - C. Walked in Evangelism – “prisoners listening”
21. God's Response(16:26)
- A. God moves visibly to demonstrate His power to the world.
 - B. God delivers and sets us free from enemy's attacks
 - C. God moves in such a way that demonstrates He is Almighty.
